SPECIAL CARE DENTISTRY POSTER PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

Posters should be no larger than A1 (24 in x 36 in), in **portrait view** and printed on good quality paper (fixings will be provided), including:

- Title of Poster
- Full name of Presenter and presenter(s) email
- List of Authors, their Job Title and their Place(s) of Work
- A suggested format is:
 - Background/Introduction
 - Aims/Objectives
 - Methods/Case summary
 - Results/Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Acknowledgements and references should be included.

Entrants must be available to present their posters at the study day.

Poster boards will be provided and posters need to be displayed **before 9 a.m.** on the morning of the conference.

All entries will be assessed on the day by a panel of judges, appointed by the SIG committee.

A prize of £100 will be awarded in each category at the meeting, only if the judges agree that its content is of a sufficiently high standard.
